

Three's Scope and Sequence

Our Three's program is designed to provide physical, emotional, intellectual and spiritual growth through free play, gym/playground time, circle time, arts/crafts, story time, Bible lessons, centers and music. We use Horizon and Zoo Phonic curriculum, along with other outside sources, which further enhances learning.

Social/Emotional Development:

- Takes turns in games
- Plays with other children
- Helps other children when asked to do so
- Participates in cleaning up classroom and classroom jobs
- Follows directions with 2-3 steps
- Explains feelings using words

Spiritual Development:

- God made me
- God loves me
- Jesus loves me and wants to be my friend forever

Intellectual Development:

- Recognizes first name
- Recognizes letters
- Sorts objects
- Counts 1-20
- Recognizes numbers 1-10
- Matches, sorts and names colors
- Knows basic shapes
- Uses language to communicate
- Answers questions from stories

- Understands simple positional words like in, out and under
- Uses language to communicate
- Starts to do independent work
- Introduces letter sounds

Physical Development/Gross and Fine Motor Skills:

- Uses crayons, markers and glue
- Begins to use scissors
- Starts to write name, letters, numbers, and shapes
- Shapes playdoh
- Tears paper
- Completes puzzles with some assistance
- Holds book correctly, turning pages one at a time
- Walks forward and backward and changes directions on command
- Puts together parts (puzzles, small manipulatives, etc.)
- Washes and dries hands
- Strings beads/Laces cards
- Draws pictures
